


Register. Raise funds. Save animal lives.

Please check in at the Starting Line between 9am and 9:45am.

This fun run is not a chip-timed run. We will have a large display timer at the finish line for you to note your time.

The race route is approximately 5 kilometers in length and leaves from the Downtown Waterfront Park.

All runners will pick up their race bib and route map at the Runner Registration Tent the morning of the event.

Runner Registration is located at the Starting Line.

You can pick up your event tote and fundraising prizes at Prize Pickup before OR after the race.

Race begins promptly at 10am.

Dogs are welcome to join you!

The route follows the Waterfront Trail along SE Columbia Way, under the I5 bridge. The turnaround point is the Wendy the Welder Sculpture near Beaches Restaurant.
